CASA Home Sale



CASA requesting letter from OCPEH about home sale

- 3-bedroom, 2 bath single family home in Hillsborough
- Receives CoC Operating dollars under RA/Operating grant
- Sale process
 - County or non-profit buyer (use home to serve households under 80% AM) unlikely but preferable to increase # affordable units
 - Open market would leave affordable housing stock
- CASA needs a letter from OCPEH as CoC to reinvest funds in Orange County
 - ·Building is no longer needed or suitable for original purpose
 - •Sale of the property is consistent with the CoC strategic plan

Continuum of Care (CoC) has two meanings, which is confusing

CoC = source of HUD funding
 Large source of homeless funding



 CoC = planning area
 Geographically defined group responsible for homeless services planning & implementation






CoC application involves Leadership Team & other community members

- •Role of Leadership Team
 - Approving scorecard
 - Approving project priority listing





HUD dictates timeline, likely to be June - September

July

- Renewal project apps
- ·Solicit new projects
- Develop scorecard

August

- Leadership Team approves scorecard
- ·Project apps due
- Project Review Committee
- Community app work begins
- Leadership Team approves project priority listing

September

- Project apps revised
- Community app reviewed, revised, finalized
- •All submitted to HUD
