- Welcome & Updates
  - Agency Updates
    - DSS-job fair at university mall; veterans memorial to be built near Southern Human Services Center on land donated by county; dedication at the site on Veterans Day; Veterans Day breakfast as Passmore Center in Hillsborough-anyone welcome
    - Durham VA-all vouchers are dedicated to veterans currently; trying to get more from Durham housing authority; maybe some room to negotiate with Orange Housing authority; Lindsay promoted to chief, her position will be filled soon, Doneicia Johnson will be new shelter outreach staff
    - VoA-renewed for new grant year; waiting for Oct. for money to come through;(1.5 mill-same as last year) will they do anything differently than last year? Changes from SSVF and VoA will be discussed next week at training meeting-update next month; some money may be focused on prevention; past money has largely been prioritized for RRH; Jonathan will send out updated grant map when it becomes available
    - OCPEH-gearing up for Project Connect; CoC app submitted last week
- Veteran stand-down in Durham was Sept. 16, went well; Durham has received USICH certification of ending veteran chronic homelessness
- CoC community application
  - Review of Veteran Strategic Goals Corey will send veterans section of CoC application to review in October
- Triangle-wide collaboration
  - Helpful because veterans often go between county lines, are seen by multiple counties' services; don't see Wake-Orange nearly as often as Durham-Orange
- Consent Form
  - Corey will revise both groups' consent forms and send to Charlotte to be approved by lawyer
  - Hope to start in October with review of by-name list
